*We recommend measuring the cake pan yourself rather than relying on the size stated by the manufacturer. In the list of cake pan sizes, find a pan size that closely matches the one you wish to use. Multiply the original recipe ingredient quantities by the figure in the right column that corresponds to your chosen pan size. This will produce a cake of similar height to the original cake. If you would like to make the cake taller than the original, multiply the ingredient quantities by a slightly larger number than suggested.
